

Request for last paper version of digital title

When to use this form: If you want to know the history of the property prior to digital conversion (2001-2002) you may need a copy of the previous version of the Certificate of Title. These records are also known as "Parchment Title", 'Superseded', 'Last Paper Version' or 'Sketch Title' and used to describe paper certificates of Title that remained after digitilisation of the Land Title Register in 2001.

What does this record include? Typically, paper records contained sketches showing the land 'coloured green' being the subject land description. Exceptions include: land that is strata titled (purple title), multi lot/titles and crown land records. These are examples where the definitive source of land measurements remains the survey that created the lot.
