- Go to the login page of the Application for Objection Portal.
- 2 Enter your username and password and click the 'Log in' button.
- 3 Follow the instructions to download the Salesforce Authenticator App.
- Follow the prompts on the Authenticator set up and enter the two-word phrase displayed on your computer device.
- Complete the connection to your Application for Objection Portal account by following the prompts on the Authenticator.
- You will be logged in to the Application for Objection Portal.
- When you login next time you will be prompted to click Approve on the Salesforce Authenticator App.



sensitive


Click 'Connect'. This will connect the Authenticator to your Valuation Services **Application for Objection** Portal account.



- 3. Click "Allow only while using the app"


Then click on the back arrow at the top left of the screen.
